

# How to check out Kindle ebooks at the Library

Here's a quick walk-through of using a computer to download a library book.

**You will need BOTH a Library Card and an Amazon account.**

First, go to <http://overdrive.poudrelibraries.org> and **find an ebook** that you are interested in.

You have the option to **limit your search by 'Kindle book.'**



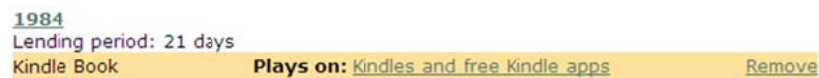
Make a selection and click **'Add to eCart.'**



This takes you to your eCart. Click **'Proceed to Checkout.'**
