## Taxpayers Eligible for VITA Services

- Income up to \$49,000
- Seniors age 60+ (no complex returns).
- Persons with special needs.
- Homebound persons (call 211 or 970-372-5419).
- Non English-speaking persons (if translators are available).

## Bring the following to any location

- Tax-related records.
  - 2008 tax return forms.
  - All W-2s, 1099s, 1098-Ts and/or other forms that show income.
  - Sold house or foreclosure? Bring closing papers.
  - Sold stock? Bring original cost of stock.
  - Other information needed to prepare your tax forms.
- Family information.
  - Social Security cards and birth dates of all family members/dependents.
  - Form 9332 for child not living with parent.
  - Power of Attorney for spouse if spouse not present at time of tax preparation.
- Blank check for direct deposit of refund.
