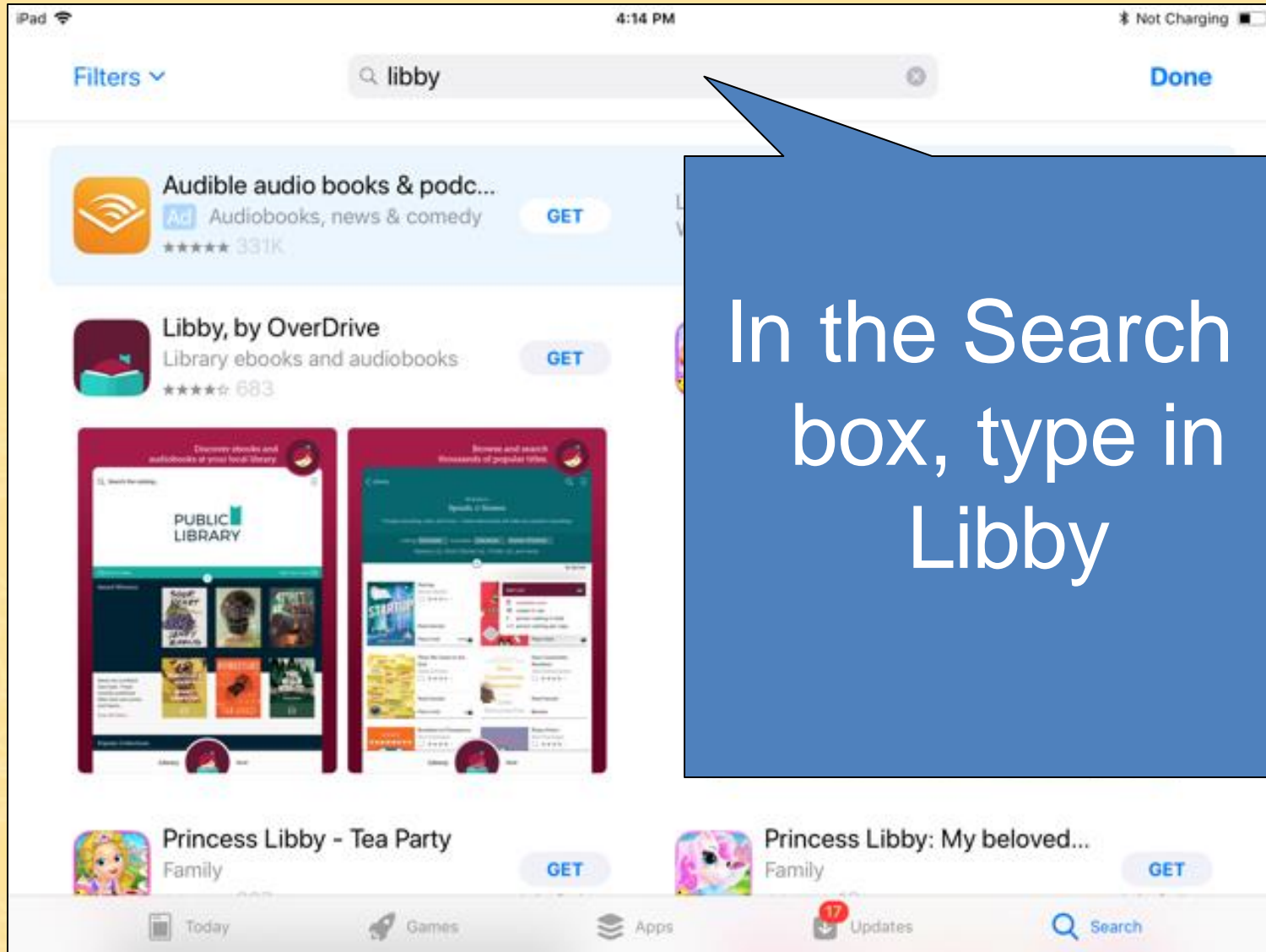

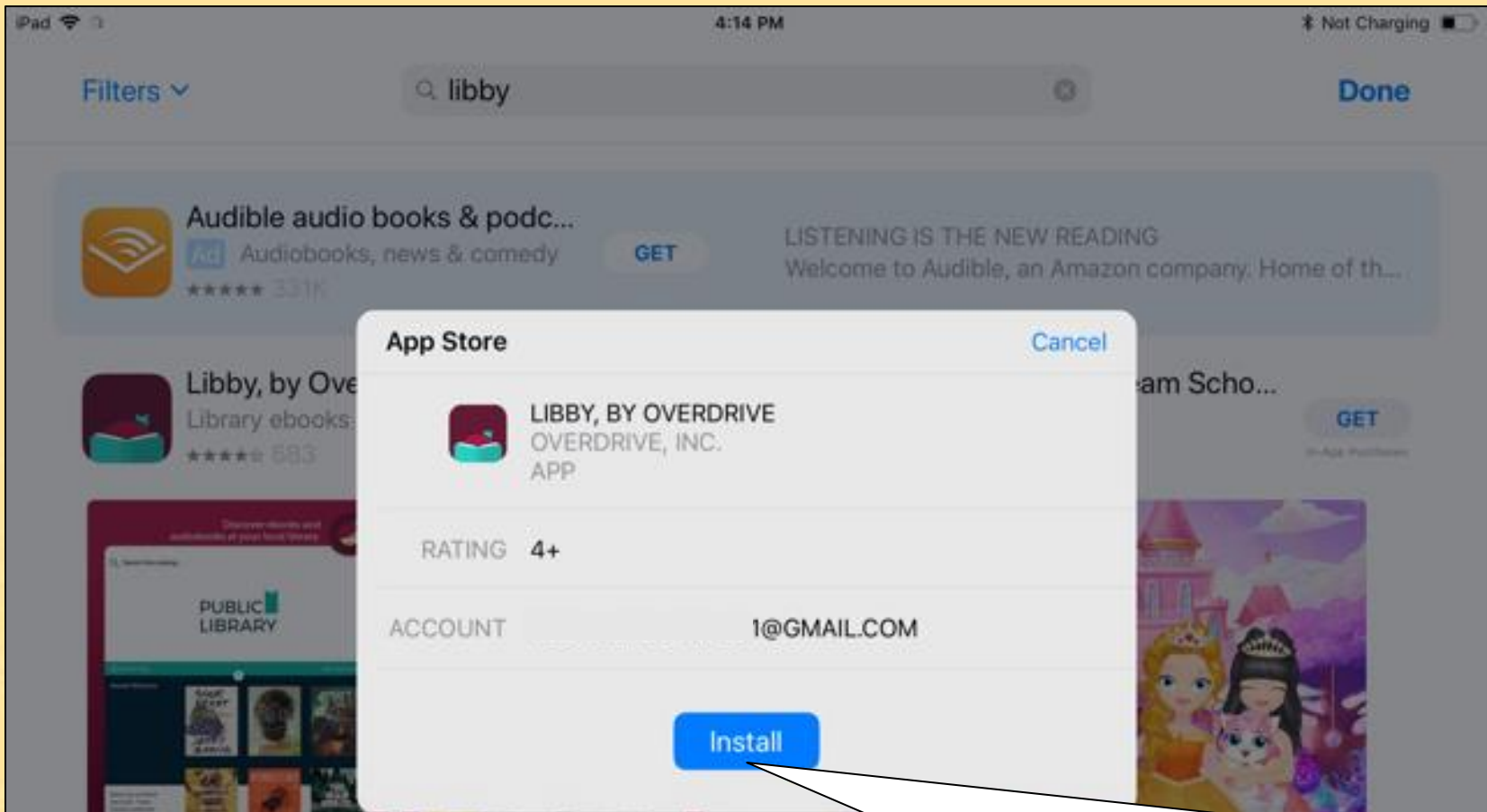
Libby for iOS 9 and up

Go to the Apple App store

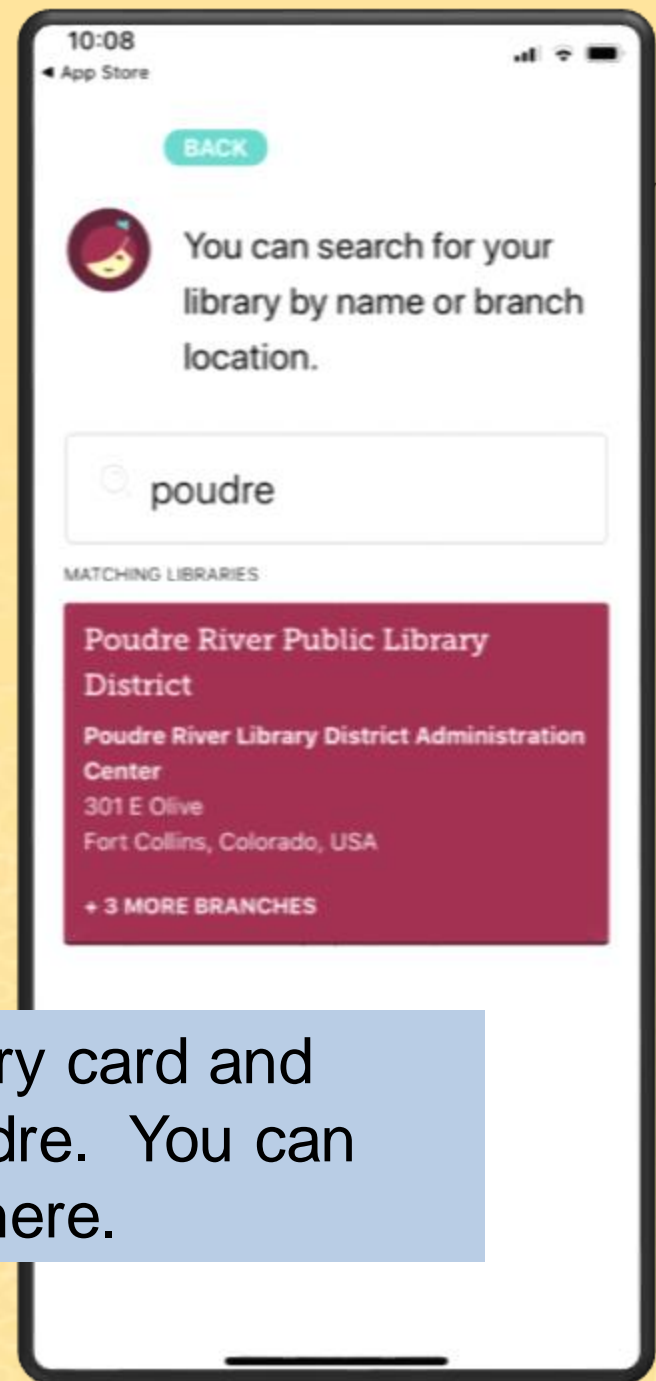
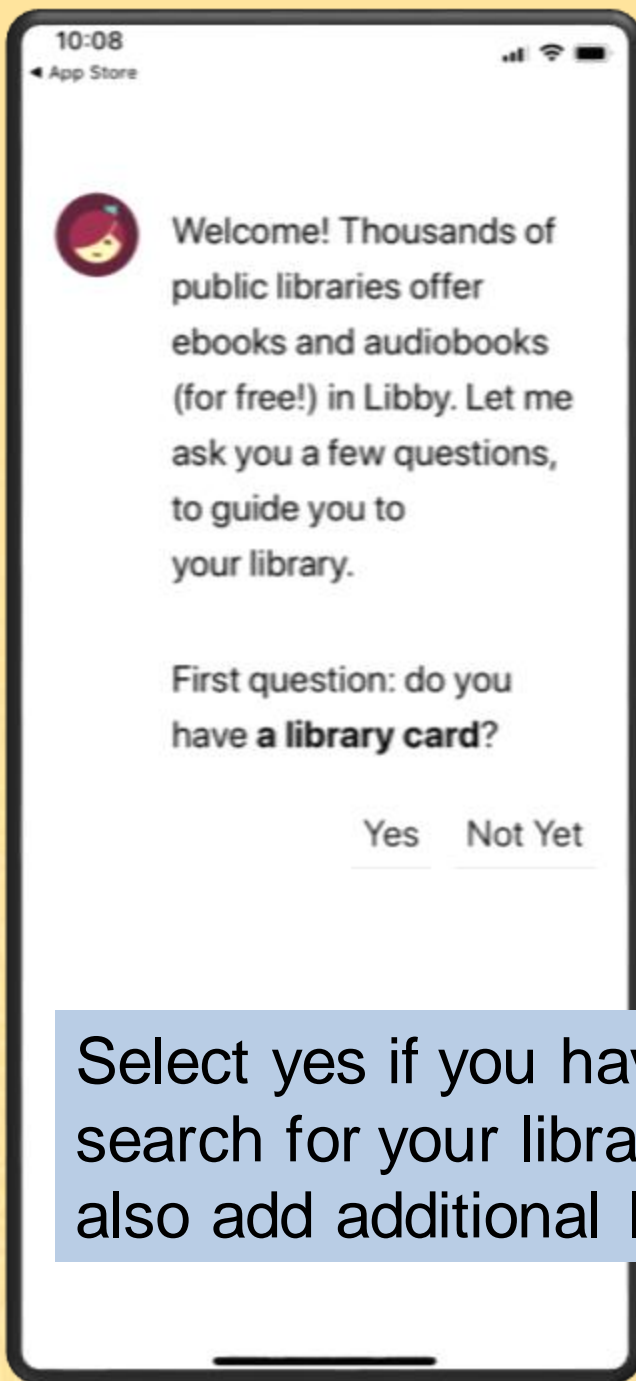

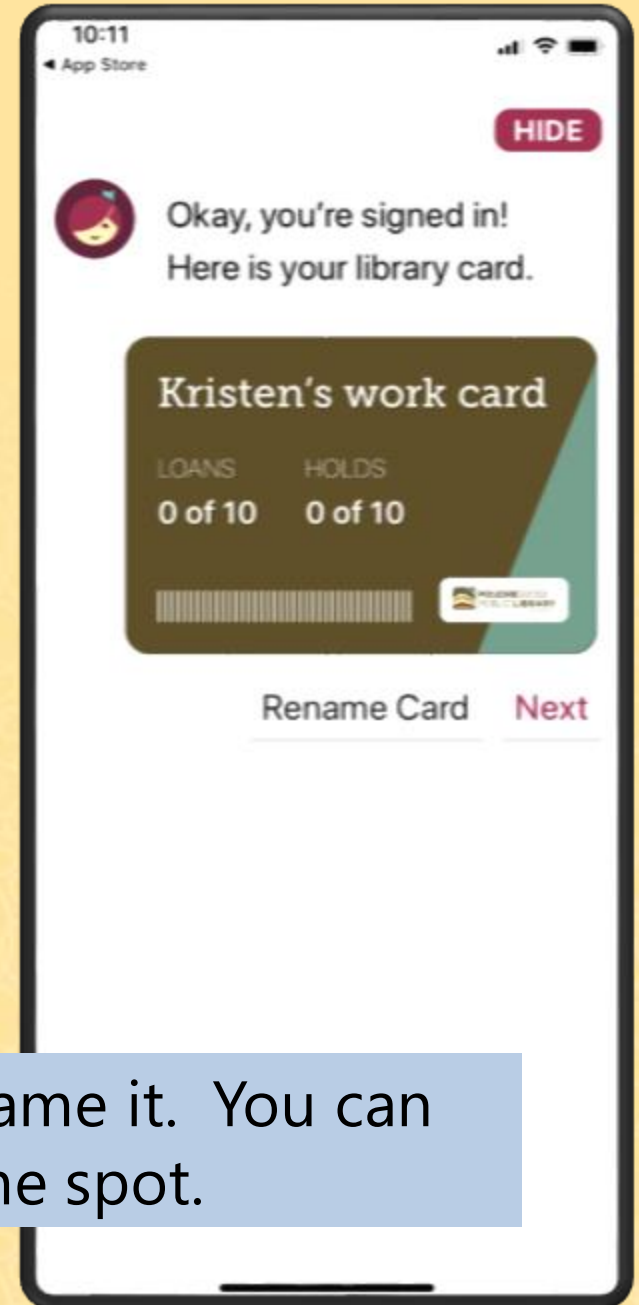
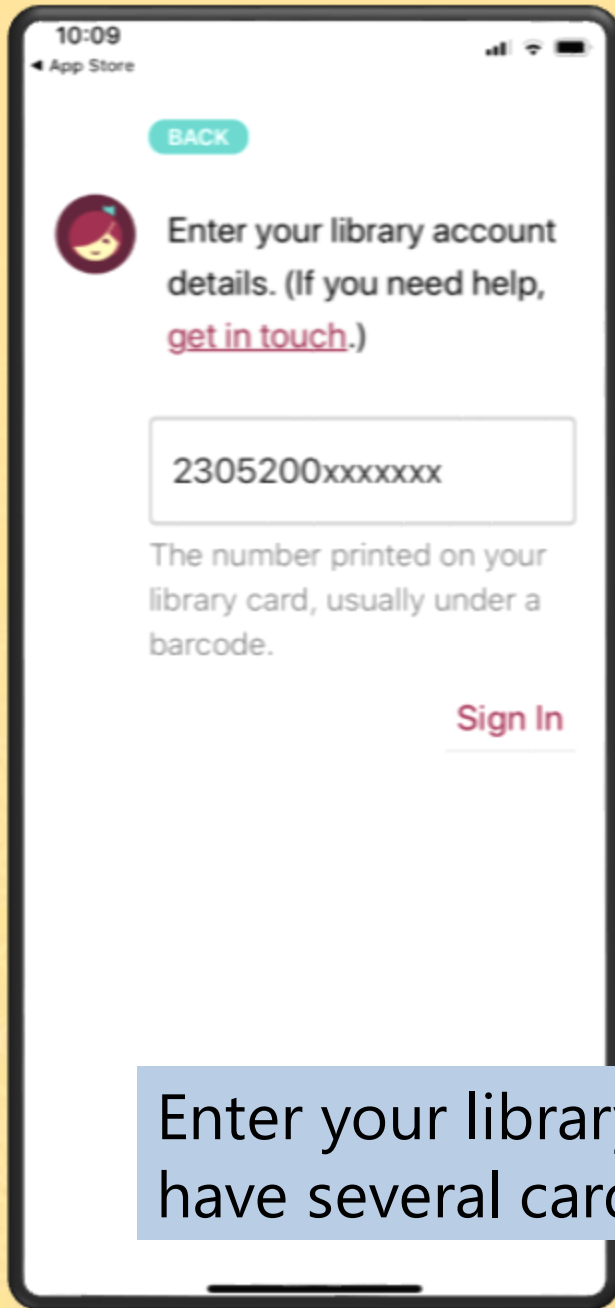




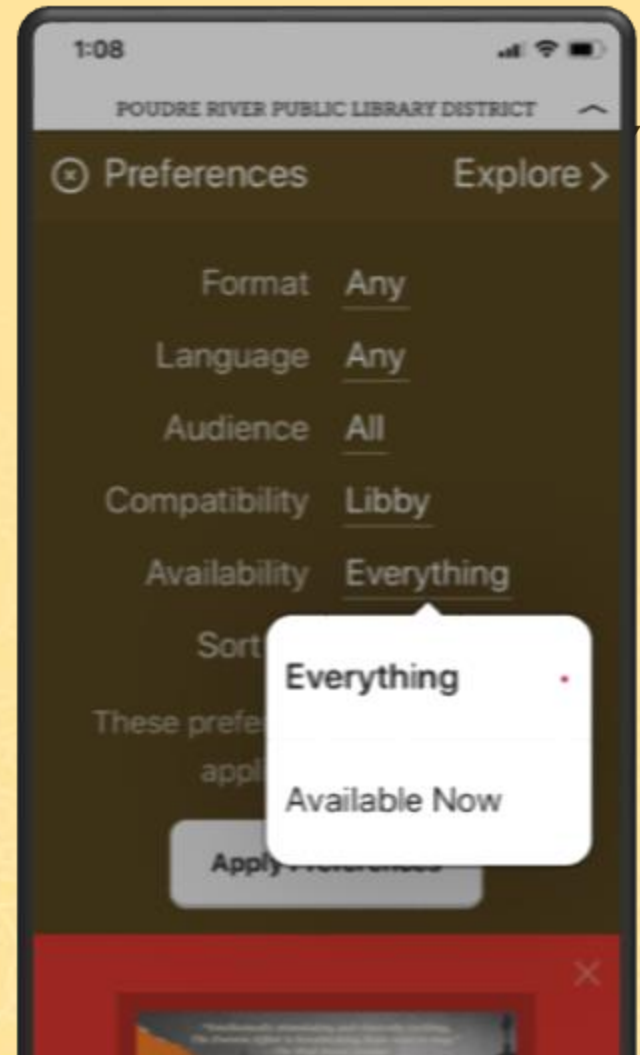
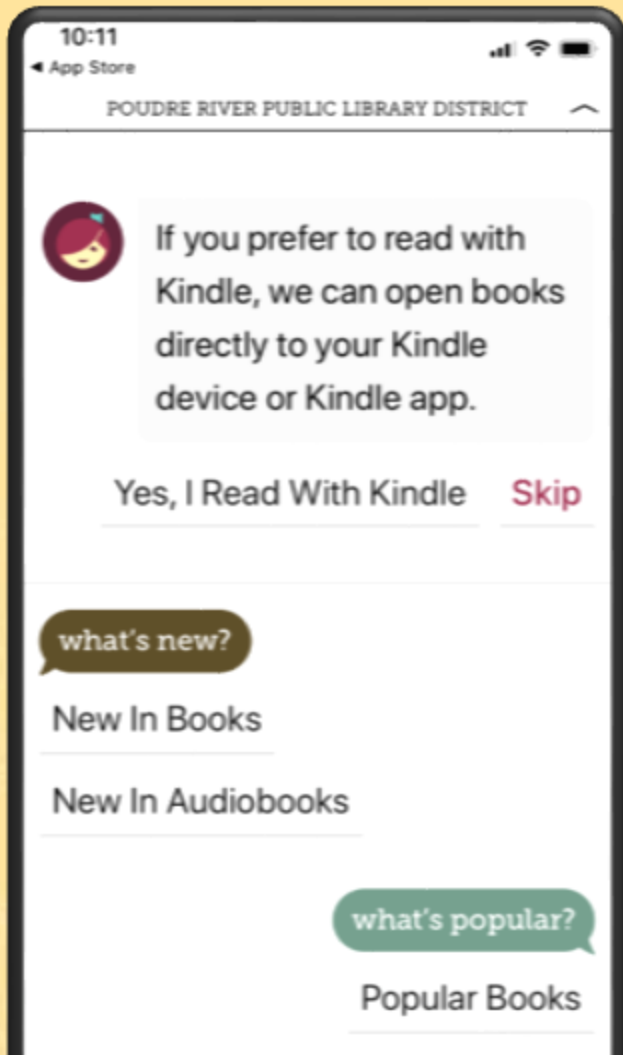
Select Libby, by Overdrive.
Tap on Get, then Install, and then
Open.



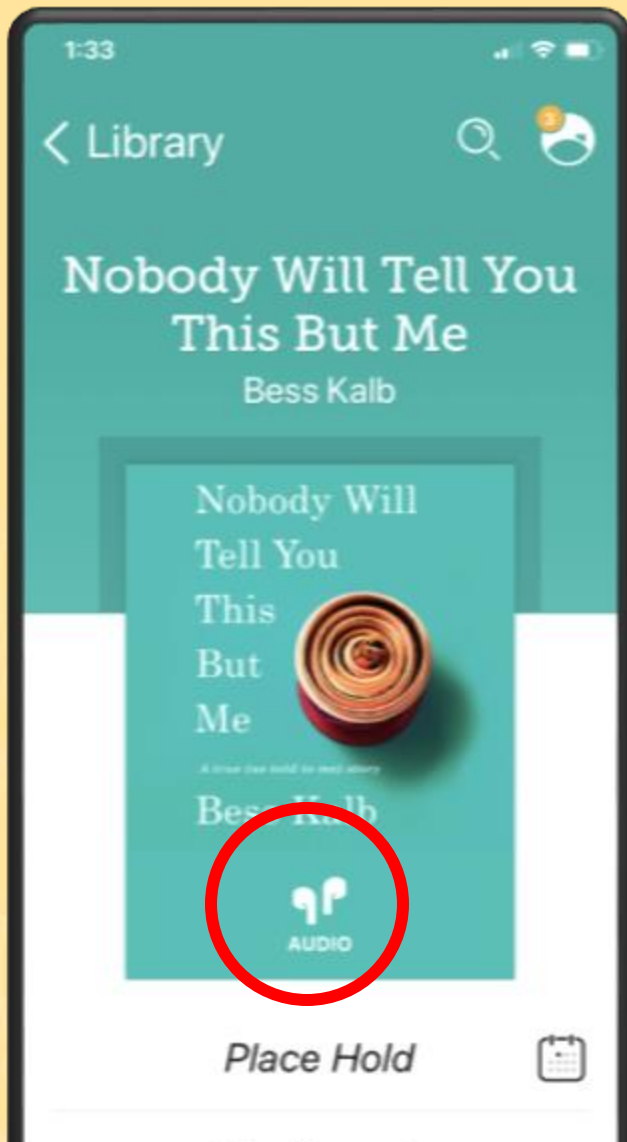
Select yes if you have a library card and search for your library – Poudre. You can also add additional libraries here.



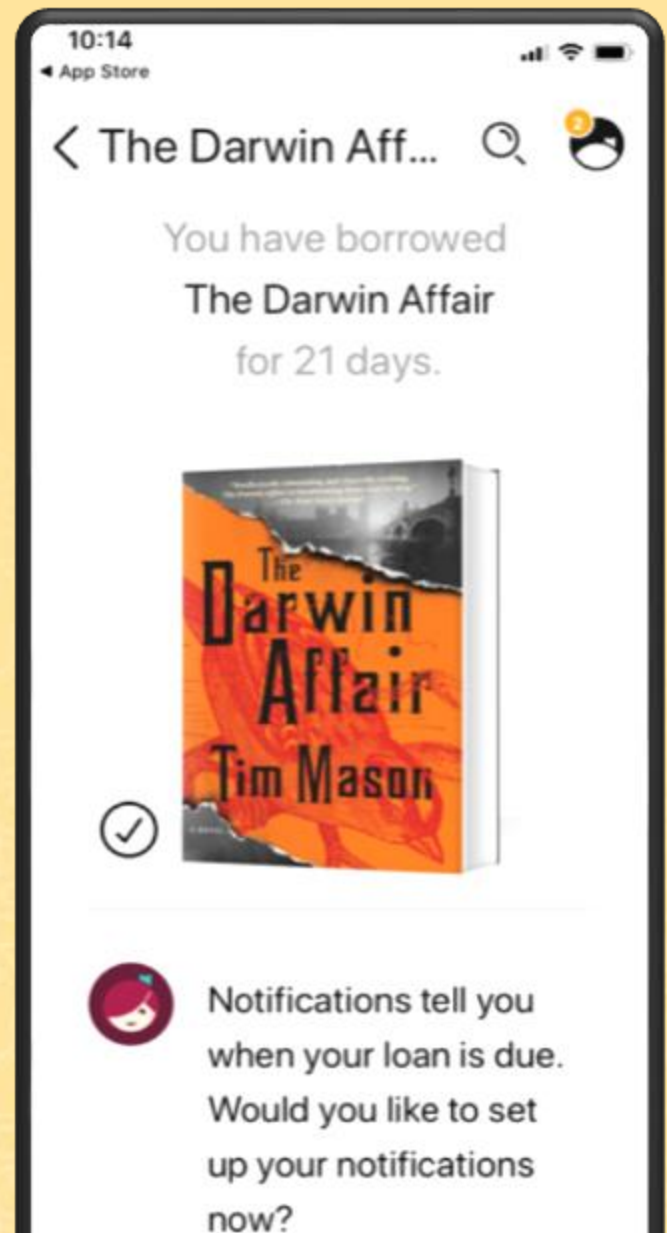
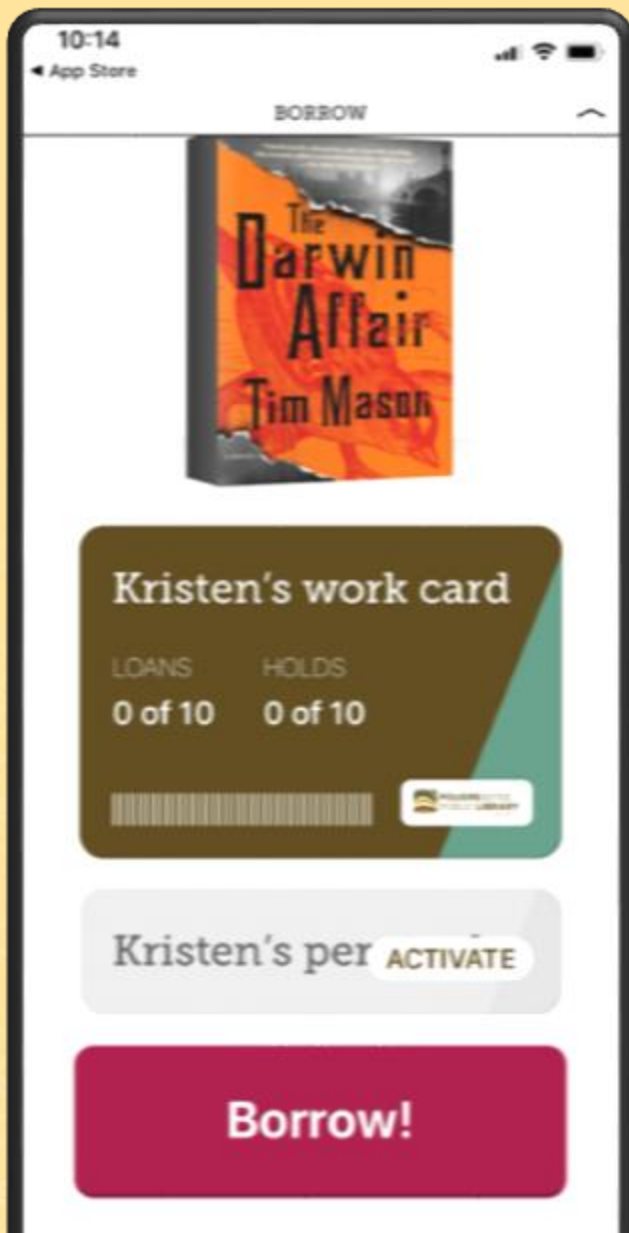
Enter your library card and name it. You can have several cards in this same spot.



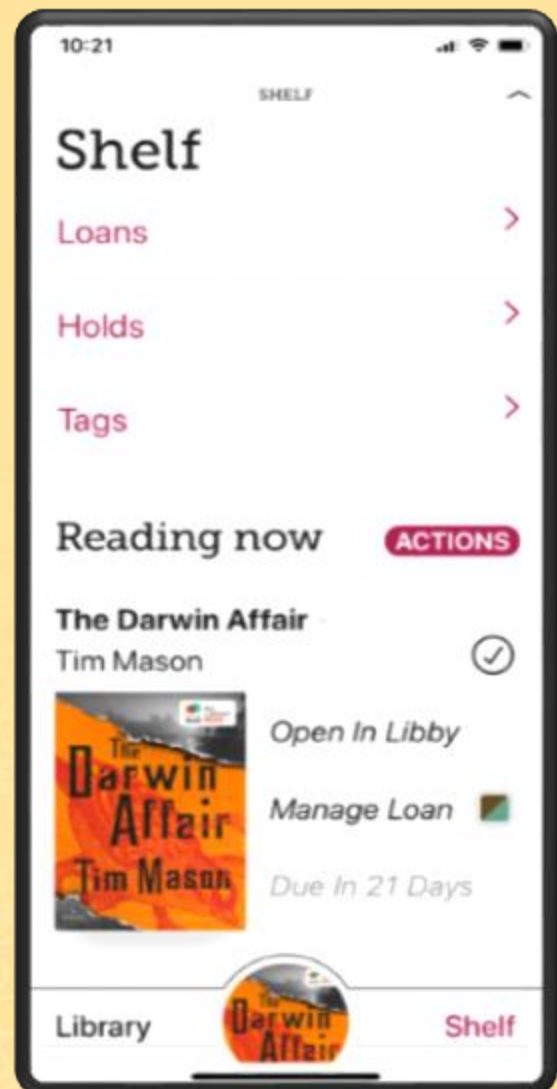
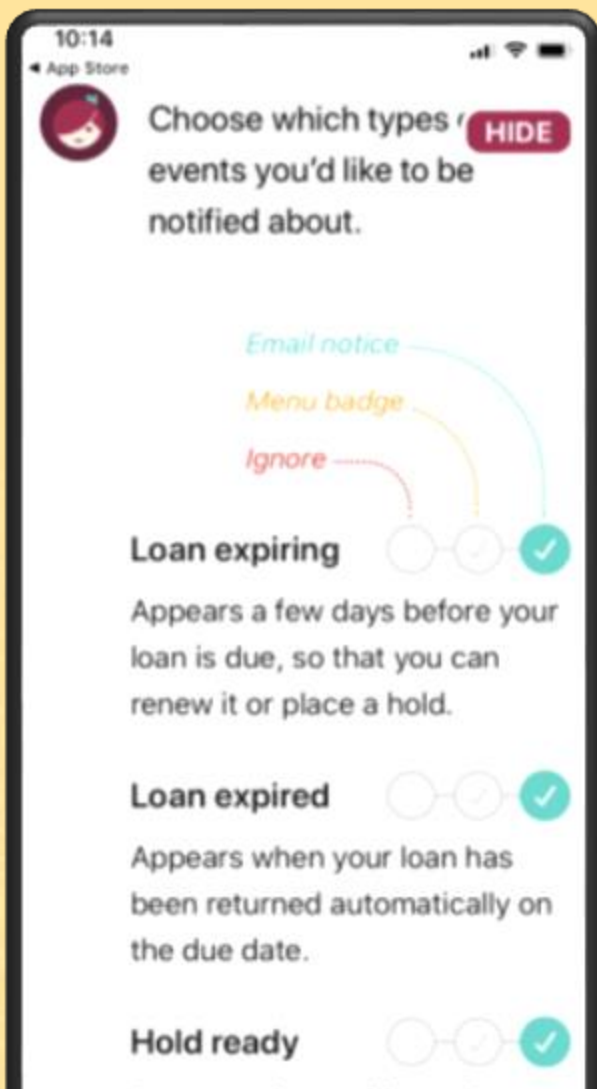
You can select Kindle books if you read with a Kindle app. When you look in the Library for an item, you can change various preferences.



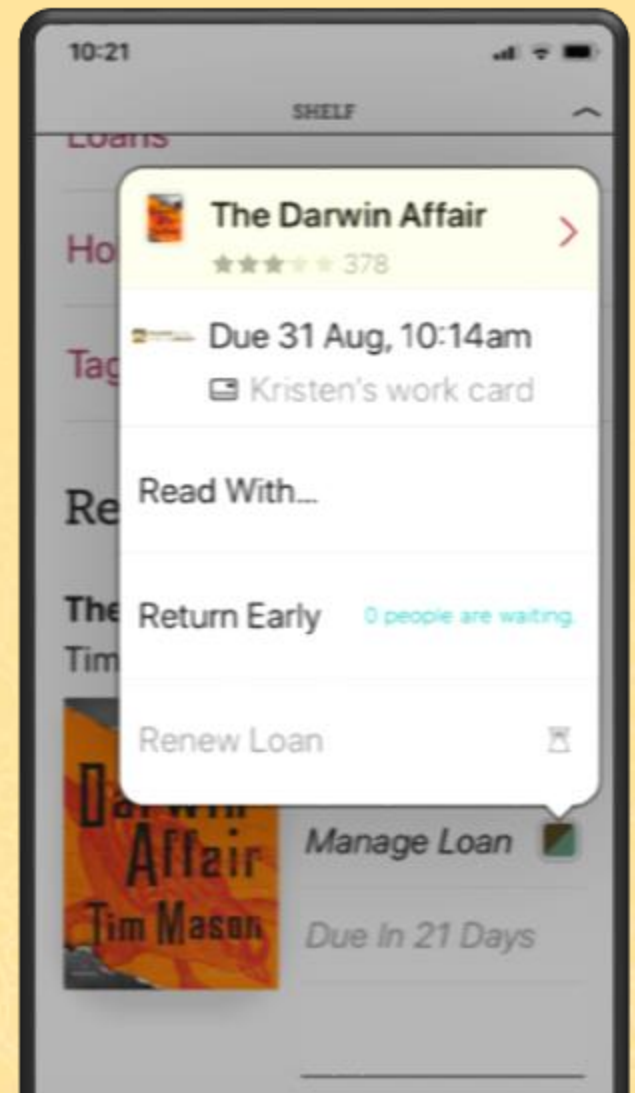
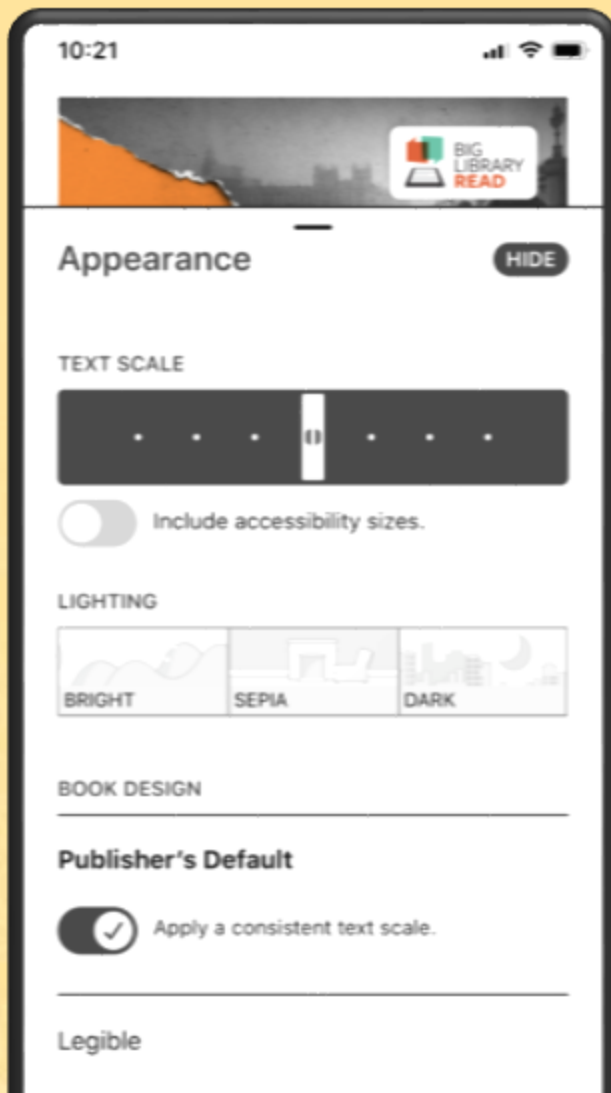
Select the item you want to check out. Notice the earbuds if you have selected and audiobook.



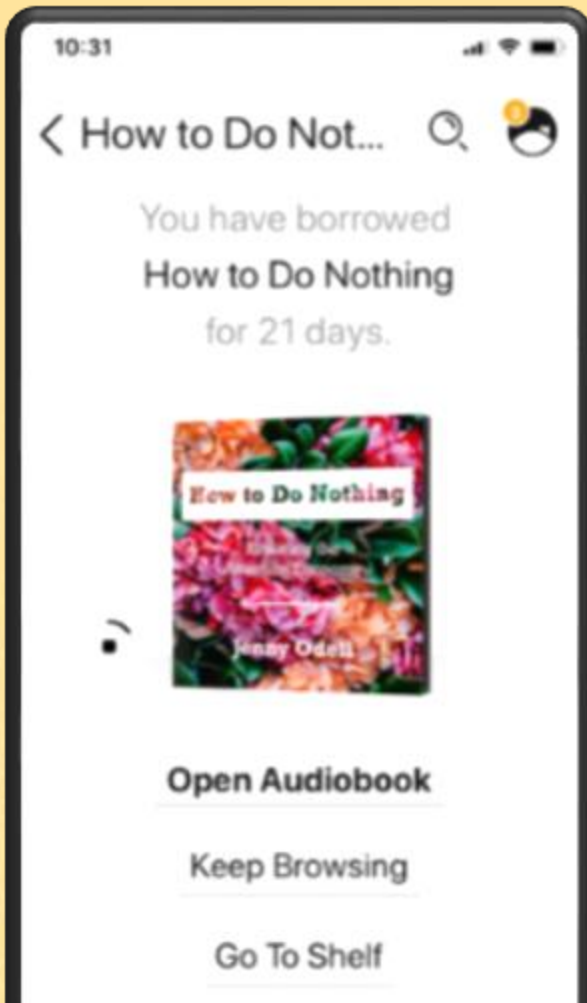
Click on borrow. You will have the item for 21 days.



You can choose what you'd like to be notified about in Libby. Tap on Shelf to see what you have checked out. Tap on holds to see where you are in line for a hold.



You can change the appearance of the text and background within the ebook. You can also return the item early if you desire.



Audiobooks will download for offline listening. You can set the speed, set a sleep timer, create bookmarks and highlights, and skip ahead and back in 15 second intervals.
